Prof.(Dr.) M L S Deva Kumar, FIE Hon. Secretary, IEI APSC Said RRR means Reduce, Recycle and Reuse (RRR) Centres established across the city to save the environment. Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) on Saturday opened **RRR** (reduce-reuse-recycle) centres across the city. These centres will collect unusable materials from households and help recycle and reuse them.

Ministry of housing & urban affairs, government of India, in collaboration with ministry of environment, forest and climate change, initiated the Meri LiFE Mera Swachh Shahar campaign which will culminate on World Environment Day on June 5. As part of the drive, VMC inaugurated 68 RRR centres. District collector S Dilli Rao, VMC commissioner Swapnil Dinakar Pundkar, MLAs Malladi Vishnuvrdhan, and Vellampalli Srinivas, major Rayana Bhagya Lakshmi and others participated in the inauguration of RRR centres.

“The RRR centres will serve as a hub for residents to donate their old clothes, old books, plastic waste, old toys, flower waste, and e-waste. The programme will continue till June 5, and the citizens are encouraged to participate by donating their recyclable items to their nearby RRR centres,” Swapnil Dinakar said.

The RRR centres will be managed by VMC and will operate on a ward-level basis. Citizens can contact nearby secretariats or the social media team for more information.
